

Events committee suggestion for new event rules:

Sacramento Area Modelers Event Qualifications and Rules for Contest Directors

Events held at the Sacramento Area Modelers (SAM) field should expose the public and the Radio Control (RC) flying community to RC flight and the SAM facility while allowing for RC pilots to participate in a safe and fun environment.

Contest Director/Event Qualifications:

- To be a Contest Director (CD) at a SAM event, the CD must be an Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) sanctioned CD and be an open SAM member
- The CD (or appointee) will need to propose the event to the SAM Board of Directors (SAM holds an event planning/scheduling meeting around December each year for the following year).
- The SAM Board of Directors will review, amend, and approve the final schedule of events.
- Historical events will take precedence with regards to bids for the event dates.
- There shall be no “back to back” events unless weather conditions force a rescheduling.

Contest Director/Event Rules:

- SAM will receive at minimum \$200.00 for a one day event and \$300.00 for a two day event (CD's that experience high participation are encouraged to contribute more).
- SAM is a not-for-profit organization and as such the Board of Directors has a responsibility to prevent even the perception that the club is being used for the profit of an individual or business. The CD will act as an agent for SAM. All money and/or donations collected are the property of the SAM. All checks will be made out to the SAM club. Within seven days of the event the CD must submit an event balance sheet, turn over all checks, and money/donations remaining from the event to the SAM Treasurer.
- The CD will require all pilots to show proof of current AMA membership in order to participate in the event.
- All AMA and SAM safety rules will apply as well as any event specific AMA and SAM rules that would apply to the type of event being run.
- The SAM site must be returned to presentable conditions.
